



NM State Parks Fee Changes

BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2025, NM STATE PARKS WILL BE IMPLEMENTING CHANGES TO OUR FEES. THESE CHANGES INCLUDE DIFFERENTIATION IN RESIDENT AND NON-RESIDENT CAMPING AND DAY USE FEES.

WHO IS CONSIDERED A RESIDENT?

A RESIDENT MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WITH A VALID NEW MEXICO STATE IDENTIFICATION CARD OR NM LICENSE PLATE ON THE VEHICLE.



- All day use fees are per vehicle per day.
- All camping fees are per vehicle per day including walk in/bicycles.
- All annual passes are valid for the calendar year purchased only and expire on December 31st annually.
- Utility fees are charged for sites with utilities available regardless of if the utility is used.
- New Mexico Residents are exempt from paying day use fees from October 1st through April 30th annually.
